

Florida Bicycle Safari COVID Policy

The Florida Freewheelers and Florida Bicycle Safari are committed to doing our part to promote the health and safety of all of our tour participants as the COVID-19 pandemic continues.

In that light, we are requiring all of our guests to be fully vaccinated or receive a negative PCR or antigen test within 72 hours of the tour start. You will need to provide proof at check-in. If you are not able to provide sufficient proof, we will be unable to welcome you at Safari. What counts as “proof”? A hard copy, digital copy or picture of your vaccine card or negative COVID test will be accepted. We’ll also accept a medical certificate confirming recovery from COVID-19 dated no more than 90 days before April 9, 2022.

We strongly urge all eligible guests to be vaccinated.

Please be respectful of others’ requests when it comes to distancing and masking.
